

## 2016-2017 2nd Grade Summer requirements

1 - Keep a reading log over the summer using the website [www.reading-rewards.com](http://www.reading-rewards.com). You will need to read a minimum of 60 minutes per week. Also, you will need to add at least a one sentence comment about what you read 1time per week and have your minutes validated (signed-off on-line) by a parent in order for them to count. I will be tracking your progress over the summer. The reading log will also count as a portion of your 1st quarter reading grade. Anyone who reaches the goal of 600 minutes of reading over the summer will receive a special treat the 1st week of school. If the entire class reaches this goal, we will have a party to start the year!

2 - You will be required to keep up with your Math skills over the summer. You will be creating a Khan Academy account in order to work on K-2 math skills. You are required to work on this a minimum of 20 minutes per week for 9 of the 11 weeks of the summer. I will be checking your progress throughout the summer as well.

3 - Math Facts - You are required to work on your addition math facts (sums through 10) 25 minutes per week. You will be tested on proficiency of your addition math facts the first week of school. You will be given 30 problems to complete in 1 minute. This will also be counted towards your first quarter grade in math.
