4th Grade Summer Reading Project

Have you read a great book this summer and want to share it with your classmates? It's time for Cereal Box Book Reports! Using an empty cereal box, create your book report with these directions:

Write or type your answers and either glue/tape them to the appropriate spot on the box. Due the first day of school!

(I recommend a standard size cereal box not a small one.)

Entire Box:

Cover the box with white paper or light colored paper. Wrap neatly like you would a present.

Front of Box:

Think of a name for your new cereal that is related to your book. Design the front of your box to be eye catching and unique. Be sure **to include the title and author** of the book.

Back of Box:

Every kid's cereal comes with a game or puzzle on the back of the box! Create a maze, word search, word scramble, or any other game for your box. Please make sure it relates to your book.

<u>Left Side:</u>

Write a summary of your book and attach to the left side of box. Must have at least 5 to 7 sentences.

<u>Right Side:</u>

Write a list of at least 3 characters and write 1 to 2 sentences about each character. Write at least 2 sentences about where the story takes place.

Top of the Box:

Write a review about the book. Would you recommend this book to a friend or teacher? Why or why not? Must have at least 3 to 4 sentences.
