

2017-2018 2nd Grade Summer Requirements

1. Over the summer, students will keep up on their reading with a summer reading log. They will read a minimum of 60 minutes per week. Students will be sent home with a reading packet for the summer during the last week of school. In their reading packet, you will find a weekly reading log for each week of the summer. You are required to fill in at least 10 of the 11 weeks. On the back of each reading log is a response sheet. They will be expected to write three sentences a week using one of the reading log response sheet prompts in their reading packet. This means each week will have one response that is three sentences. Each reading log page must be signed by a parent in order for it to count. You will notice that reading to your child can count towards the 60 minutes. Please make sure that your child reads INDEPENDENTLY or to you for at least 40 of the minutes each week. The other 20 minutes you may read to them! The reading log will count as a portion of their 1st quarter reading grade! Anyone who reaches 600 minutes of reading over the summer will get a special treat the first week of school. If the entire class reaches the goal, we will have a party!
2. They will also be expected to keep up with their math skills over the summer. They will be using their Khan Academy account to work on their K-2 skills. They are required to work on this a minimum of 15 minutes per week for 9 of the 11 weeks of summer. I will be able to check your progress throughout the summer!
